You are a gift to this world. You are not a cog in the economic engine of society. You are more than your finances!

The "G" word is "GIVE."

A tithe means <u>ONE-TENTH</u>.

Why Give?

God (THE fabric) doesn't NEED your tithe.

Every wild animal of the forest is mine, as are the cattle on a thousand hills. I know all the birds of the air, and all the moves in the field is mine. If I were hungry, I wouldn't need to ask you, for the world and all that is in it is mine. Psalm 50.10-12

Your local church (this Fabric) or your favorite charity doesn't need <u>YOUR</u> tithe.

Because YOU NEED to give.

Giving makes a couple important things happen:

It settles the issue of what is IN CONTROL of your life.

Then he said to them, 'Whose image is this, and whose inscription?' They answered, 'The emperor's.' Then Jesus said to them, 'Give therefore to the emperor the things that are the emperor's, and to God the things that are God's.' When they heard this, they were amazed; and they left him and went away. Matthew 22.15-22
