3. IMPULSE BUYING

The cure for this is a budget, which is what we call <u>PLANNED SPENDING</u>.

If you don't gamble. Don't start. If you gamble with entertainment money and can keep it at that. Be careful. If you are gambling with money you shouldn't.Stop. If you can't stop. Get help.

Defense against the Traps

Share 10% - Off the top.

- Save 10% Set it aside before you start spending.
